## HOUSE BILL NO. 1744 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DESOTO COUNTY
TO DEPOSIT VENDING MACHINE PROCEEDS INTO A SPECIAL FUND TO BE USED
FOR BENEVOLENT PURPOSES FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County,
- 7 Mississippi, in its discretion, by resolution duly adopted and
- 8 entered on its minutes, may create a special fund in the county
- 9 treasury to be known as the "Vending Machine Special Fund," into
- 10 which may be deposited a portion of the proceeds, not to exceed
- 11 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per year, due to the county from
- 12 the vending machines located at county facilities and on property
- 13 owned by the county. Money deposited into the Vending Machine
- 14 Special Fund shall be used for the benevolent purpose of
- 15 commemorating special occasions for county employees. The board
- 16 of supervisors shall appoint a committee, to be comprised of three
- 17 (3) employees of the county, to administer the fund, and
- 18 expenditures from the fund shall be upon the recommendation of the
- 19 committee. The board of supervisors shall include guidelines for
- 20 the expenditure of monies in the Vending Machine Special Fund in
- 21 the resolution creating the fund.
- 22 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after July 1,
- 23 2004.
- 24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after its passage.
