HOUSE BILL NO. 1748
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CAROLYN BOND OF
2 TUNICA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Carolyn Bond of Tunica County, Mississippi,
6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her conviction
7 of embezzlement in Tunica County, Mississippi, in 1992, and who
8 has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon her for
9 such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed that
10 she is now conducting herself as a law-abiding and honorable
11 citizen in a good and lawful manner.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
