HOUSE BILL NO. 1754 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND, BY 1 2 AND THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, TO GRANT 3 A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT AND TO CONVEY CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, FOR 4 THE PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGH STREET; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Finance and 8 Administration, on behalf of the State of Mississippi, may convey all rights, title and interest in certain property located in 9 Hinds County, Mississippi, to the City of Jackson, Mississippi, 10 the property being more particularly described as follows: 11 A triangular-shaped parcel of land in that certain tract of 12 13 land described in the documents filed for record in the 14 office of the Chancery Clerk of the First Judicial District of Hinds County, Mississippi, in Deed Book 1764 Page 281 and 15 in Deed Book 2370 Page 206. Said tract of land being a 16 portion of 2 Acre Lot 10, North Jackson, according to the 17 official map of the City of Jackson, made by Henry C. Daniel 18 in 1875. Said triangular-shaped parcel of land being more 19 particularly described as follows: Commencing at the 20 21 southeast corner of said Lot 10, go North 08 degrees 46' 19" East a distance of 3.048 meters (10.00 feet); thence go North 2.2 81 degrees 21' 04" West for a distance of 3.048 meters (10.00 23 feet) to the intersection of the north and west line of a 24 permanent easement granted to the City of Jackson as recorded 25 in Deed Book 1820 beginning at Page 317, said point being the 26 Point of Beginning of the parcel of land described as 27

No. 1754 99\HR40\R2148 PAGE 1 28 follows, to wit: From said point of beginning, thence go North 81 degrees 21' 04" West for a distance of 6.390 meters 29 30 (20.96 feet) along the north line of said permanent easement adjacent to High Street; thence go North 44 degrees 38' 49" 31 32 East for a distance of 10.904 meters (35.77 feet) to the west 33 line of said permanent easement adjacent to Jefferson Street; thence go South 08 degrees 46' 19" West for a distance of 34 8.822 meters (28.94 feet) along west line of said permanent 35 easement adjacent to Jefferson Street to the point of 36 37 beginning.

38 (2) The conveyance authorized by this section may be made on 39 such terms and conditions agreed upon by the Department of Finance 40 and Administration and the governing authorities of the City of 41 Jackson, Mississippi, to be in the best interest of both parties 42 as well as the citizens of the community.

(3) Any funds received by the State of Mississippi for the
conveyance of the real property described in subsection (1) of
this section shall be deposited into the Mississippi Schools for
the Blind and Deaf Repair and Renovation Fund No. 3912.

47 (4) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
48 to the real property sold pursuant to this section, with the
49 rights of ingress and egress to remove such minerals.

50 SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Finance and 51 Administration, on behalf of the State of Mississippi, may grant a 52 temporary easement to the City of Jackson, Mississippi, over and 53 across certain state-owned property, the property being more 54 particularly described as follows:

55 Two strips of land, each 1.52 meters (5.00 feet) in width and across that certain tract of land described in the documents 56 57 filed for record in the office of the Chancery Clerk of the First Judicial District of Hinds County, Mississippi, in Deed 58 Book 1764 Page 281 and in Deed Book 2370 Page 206. Said 59 tract of land being a portion of 2 Acre Lot 10, North 60 Jackson, according to the official map of the City of 61 62 Jackson, made by Henry C. Daniel in 1875.

63 The first of said 1.52 meter (5.0 feet) wide strips of land64 being adjacent to, contiguous with, and northerly of the

No. 1754 99\HR40\R2148 PAGE 2 65 present north right-of-way line of High Street and more particularly the north line of that certain permanent 66 67 easement granted to the City of Jackson as recorded in the office of said Chancery Clerk in Deed Book 1820 at Page 317. 68 The north line of this 1.52 meter (5.0 feet) wide strip of 69 land commences at a point on the west boundary of said tract 70 of land at a point which is a distance of 1.52 meters (5.00 71 feet) north of said permanent easement and runs South 81 72 degrees 21' 04" East for a distance of 39.986 meters (131.19 73 74 feet) to its point of terminus.

The second of said 1.52 meter (5.0 feet) wide strips of land 75 76 being adjacent to, contiguous with, and westerly of the present west right-of-way line of Jefferson Street and more 77 78 particularly the west line of that certain permanent easement granted to the City of Jackson as recorded in the office of 79 80 said Chancery Clerk in Deed Book 1820 at Page 317. The west 81 line of this 1.52 meter (5.0 feet) wide strip of land commences at a point on the north boundary of said tract of 82 83 land at a point which is a distance of 1.52 meters (5.00 feet) west of said permanent easement and runs South 08 84 degrees 46' 19" West for a distance of 73.116 meters (239.88 85 feet) to its point of terminus. 86

87 (2) The temporary easement authorized by this section may be 88 made on such terms and conditions agreed upon by the Department of 89 Finance and Administration and the governing authorities of the 90 City of Jackson, Mississippi, to be in the best interest of both 91 parties as well as the citizens of the community.

92 (3) Proceeds of the property interest attributable to the
93 State of Mississippi shall be deposited into the Mississippi
94 Schools for the Blind and Deaf Repair and Renovation Fund No.
95 3912.

96 SECTION 3. This act shall be deemed to be full and complete 97 authority for the exercise of the powers herein granted.
