HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO INTRODUCE 1 2 AND SUPPORT THE PASSAGE OF LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING SUCH FUNDS AS 3 MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW FOUR-LANE BRIDGE ACROSS THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT OR NEAR 4 5 GREENVILLE, MISSISSIPPI. WHEREAS, the economic development and continued growth of any 6 7 area is closely connected to its transportation network; and 8 WHEREAS, U.S. Highway 82 is a major part of the Mississippi Delta's transportation network and is designated as part of the 9 National Highways of Significance system; and 10 WHEREAS, U.S. Highway 82 connects the Mississippi Delta to 11 Interstate 55 and other four-lane highways like U.S. Highway 61 12 13 (north of U.S. Highway 82) and U.S. Highway 65, and will soon be 14 four-laned from border to border in Mississippi; and WHEREAS, the present U.S. Highway 82 bridge near Greenville, 15 Mississippi, which carries traffic entering and exiting Arkansas 16 and which is economically significant to both the Mississippi 17 Delta and southeast Arkansas, is considered a serious navigational 18 hazard; and 19 WHEREAS, a feasibility study has been completed and 20 21 engineering and design studies will soon be completed that call for the construction of a new four-lane span bridge on U.S. 2.2 23 Highway 82, built to interstate highway standards, with input by the Corps of Engineers on the bridge's location: 24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 25 26 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 27 THEREIN, That we do hereby memorialize the United States Congress

No. 12 99\HR03\R744 PAGE 1 to introduce and to work in a diligent and proactive manner to support and secure the passage of such legislation as may be necessary to provide funds during the 1999-2000 fiscal year to construct a new four-lane bridge along U.S. Highway 82 near Greenville, Mississippi, in accordance with such engineering and design standards as may be appropriate.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be 35 furnished to the President of the United States Senate, the 36 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, each member 37 of the Mississippi Congressional Delegation and members of the 38 Capitol Press Corps.
