- 2 OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENTS AS A YOUNG MUSICIAN IN THE STATE OF
- 3 MISSISSIPPI.
- WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham, born September 1, 1985, in Jackson,
- 5 Mississippi, is the son of two musically talented parents, Mr. and
- 6 Mrs. Gary Worsham; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham attends Grenada Middle School where
- 8 he is a seventh grade student; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a talented young musician, Charlie Worsham is an
- 10 award winning young man blessed with extraordinary gifts of
- 11 playing the fiddle, the banjo and the piano, which is his best
- 12 instrument; and
- 13 WHEREAS, while in kindergarten, Charlie Worsham began piano
- 14 lessons with Cindy Dugan, whose excellent guidance allowed Charlie
- 15 to get the foundation he needed to excel in his other instruments;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham has received numerous awards for his
- 18 piano playing including Superior-Plus ratings for six years by the
- 19 Teacher's Guild of America, Superior ratings for four years by the
- 20 Mississippi Music Teacher's Association and in 1998, took first
- 21 place in the competitive category for the State of Mississippi in
- 22 the Bach Music Festival at Hinds Community College; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham has also been awarded prizes for
- 24 playing the banjo and the fiddle in the Mississippi State Fair,
- 25 placing third in 1995, for the banjo; finishing second in 1996,
- 26 for the banjo and in 1997, taking second prize for the banjo and

- 27 fourth place for the fiddle; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham was invited to perform at the Grand
- 29 Ole Opry in Nashville, Tennessee, where he demonstrated his
- 30 remarkable musical skills on the banjo when he made a guest
- 31 appearance with Opry star Mike Snider; and
- 32 WHEREAS, after his outstanding performance at the Grand Ole
- 33 Opry, Charlie Worsham received a standing ovation from the
- 34 audience; and
- 35 WHEREAS, a model student who makes straight A's, Charlie
- 36 Worsham is not only talented musically but academically as well;

- 38 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham discovered a love for spelling in
- 39 the fourth grade and began entering spelling bees, winning the
- 40 MPSEA District and State first place and taking fifth place in the
- 41 regional competition in Charleston, South Carolina, in the fourth
- 42 grade; placing second in the MPSEA District and State and winning
- 43 first place honors in the Southeast Region in the fifth grade and
- 44 placing 14th in the Big Bee sponsored by the Commercial Appeal in
- 45 Memphis in the sixth grade; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to his achievements in Spelling Bee
- 47 Contests, Charlie Worsham won the DAR Essay Contest in the fifth
- 48 grade, the Arbor Day Poster Contest in the fifth grade and placed
- 49 third in the school Science Fair in the sixth grade; and
- 50 WHEREAS, Charlie Worsham was a member of the Grenada Middle
- 51 School sixth grade band and voted "Outstanding Band Member" by his
- 52 peers; and
- 53 WHEREAS, because of his talent, Charlie Worsham has been
- 54 given the honor to play the guitar and fiddle in the Grenada High
- 55 School Jazz Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Legislature finds it most appropriate to pay
- 57 special tribute to such an outstanding young musician as Charlie
- 58 Worsham, who has made a remarkable contribution to the cultural
- 59 life of the State of Mississippi:
