- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 8 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendments to the Mississippi
- 9 Constitution of 1890 are proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 10 state:
- 11 I.
- 12 Amend Section 99, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 13 as follows:
- 14 "Section 99. The Legislature shall not elect any other than
- 15 its own officers * * *."
- 16 II.
- 17 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by repealing
- 18 Section 106 which reads as follows:
- 19 "Section 106. There shall be a State Librarian, to be chosen
- 20 by the Legislature, on joint vote of the two (2) houses to serve
- 21 four (4) years, whose duties and compensation shall be prescribed
- 22 by law."
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That these proposed amendments shall
- 24 be submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors
- 25 at an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first
- 26 Monday of November 1999, as provided by Section 273 of the
- 27 Constitution and by general law, with the amendments in this
- 28 resolution being voted on as one (1) amendment since the proposed

- 29 amendments pertain to one (1) subject.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 31 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 32 constitutional amendment deletes the provisions which require the
- 33 State Librarian to be chosen by the Legislature."
