The Legislature shall not enact legislation that 12 will require new expenditures of county or municipal funds unless: 13 14 (a) (i) The Legislature finds and declares that the legislation fulfills an important state interest; and 15 16 (ii) The legislation is passed by a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5) of the members of each house present and 17 18 voting; or 19 (b) Funds for the required new expenditures are provided by the state during the same legislative session at which 20 the legislation is enacted." 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed 27 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed 28 constitutional amendment prohibits the Legislature from passing 29 30 laws which require new expenditures by counties or municipalities unless the Legislature finds such laws to be of an important state 31 32 interest and passes them by a three-fifths (3/5) majority in each house or unless the state provides funding for the required 33 34 expenditures."
