## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 67

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING J.Z. GEORGE HEAD FOOTBALL  
2 COACH FARRISS JENKINS FOR HIS OUTSTANDING COACHING CAREER WITH TWO  
3 HUNDRED VICTORIES.

4 WHEREAS, J.Z. George Head Football Coach Farriss Jenkins had  
5 an outstanding coaching career that spans over forty years and he  
6 won his 200th football game, defeating McAdams 52-24 during the  
7 1998 football season; and

8 WHEREAS, throughout his career, Head Coach Jenkins has  
9 coached several teams with perfect seasons and won the State  
10 Championship in 1982; and

11 WHEREAS, Head Coach Jenkins, a goal oriented man, set many  
12 goals for himself as a Coach and has accomplished such goals as  
13 winning the State Championship, coaching in the Mississippi  
14 All-Star Football Game, coaching in the Mississippi-Alabama  
15 All-Star Game and winning two hundred football games; and

16 WHEREAS, the J.Z. George Wildcats have been superbly coached  
17 and inspired by Head Coach Farriss Jenkins who has broadened the  
18 Wildcats' knowledge of the game and refined their skills in  
19 execution for thirty-four years; and

20 WHEREAS, Head Coach Farriss Jenkins has encouraged, loved and  
21 supported many football players during his forty years as a Coach;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature of the State of  
24 Mississippi to recognize and commend remarkable individuals such  
25 as Head Coach Farriss Jenkins, whose long and distinguished career  
26 has impacted the lives of hundreds of young people:

27           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
28 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
29 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Head Coach Farriss Jenkins for  
30 his outstanding career and winning his 200th football game and  
31 extend our heartiest wishes in all his future endeavors.
