HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 86
(As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING WAYNE
2 ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL JAGUARS FOOTBALL TEAM FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING
3 1998 SEASON AND FOR WINNING THE OVERALL CLASS 1A STATE
4 CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, the Wayne Academy High School Jaguars Football Team
6 finished the 1998 season with an outstanding record of 13 wins and
7 no losses; and

8 WHEREAS, the Jaguars defeated several teams in the state
9 playoffs, winning the District 3A Championship, the North A State
10 Championship and the Overall Class 1A State Championship; and

11 WHEREAS, the Jaguars shutout three teams this season, scoring
12 a total of 471 points during the season while limiting their
13 opponents to a total of only 140 points; and

15 various team members in recognition of their fine, dedicated play

20 WHEREAS, the Wayne Academy High School Jaguars have been
21 superbly coached and inspired by Head Coach Gary Gore and
22 Assistant Coaches Tony Bishop, Billy Caston and John Walker, who
23 have broadened the Jaguars' knowledge of the game and refined
24 their skills in execution; and

25 WHEREAS, Head Coach Gore has brought additional honor to
26 Wayne Academy High School for being named the District 3A Coach of
27 the Year and the Clarion-Ledger Coach of the Week; and

28 WHEREAS, the Jaguars have developed a winning and cooperative
29 spirit and a high degree of sportsmanship, and their activities
30 and attitude reflect great credit upon the individual players and
31 their coaches and bring honor to Wayne Academy High School; and

32 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
33 and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the youth of
34 our state, who are its future:
