22 WHEREAS, the Center provides several programs designed 23 specifically for the youth, including the Saturday Gifted Studies 24 Program, the Summer Gifted Studies Program, the Leadership Studies 25 Program, the Summer Program for Academically Talented Youth and 26 Leadership Competitions; and
