HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 92

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF MS. ESSIE
2 MYRTIS EASTERLING AND EXTENDING OUR DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HER FAMILY

12 the leadership of Reverend W.D. Ridgeway; and

16 WHEREAS, Ms. Easterling also was a member of the Electra
17 Grand Chapter of the Order, the Eastern Star and the Queen Esther
18 Chapter 65; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Easterling, a loving and devoted mother, is
20 survived by three children, Angie, Gary and Nick; and her eight
21 grandchildren, Brandon, Kristi, Toneeki, Jr., Jaime, Adrian, Gary,
