Mitchell, an allergy and immunology 3 specialist at the University of Mississippi School of Medicine, 4 5 has made outstanding contributions to the field of medicine throughout his career; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Dr. Mitchell, a resident of Jackson, Mississippi, was born on August 11, 1942, in Cleveland, Mississippi, and 8 9 graduated from Cleveland High School in 1960; and 10 WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, Dr. Mitchell furthered his education at Millsaps College, where he earned a 11 12 bachelor of science degree in biology, and he earned his doctor of medicine degree from the University of Mississippi School of 13 Medicine in 1967; and 14 WHEREAS, throughout his career, Dr. Mitchell's hospital 15 16 appointments include Chief of Medicine, Medical Executive Committee, Chief of Allergy, Medical Education Committee, 17 Respiratory Therapy Committee, Utilization Review Committee, 18 19 Patient Education Committee and the Institutional Review Board, which were all at the Mississippi Baptist Medical Center in 20 21 Jackson, Mississippi; and WHEREAS, certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine 22 23 and the American Board of Allergy and Immunology, Dr. Mitchell 24 also is part of the consulting staff at St. Dominic's Hospital, Methodist Medical Center and River Oaks Hospital, and is a 25

28 WHEREAS, Dr. Mitchell has served in various leadership 29 positions of several professional organizations such as a delegate 30 to the American Medical Association, former president of the 31 Mississippi State Medical Association, former president of the 32 Central Medical Society, president-elect of the American College 33 of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology and the Board of Governors for 34 the American Association of Certified Allergists; and

35 WHEREAS, Dr. Mitchell has been the principal investigator for 36 clinical research by the Mississippi Asthma and Allergy Clinic, 37 which has conducted nearly 50 research projects, and he has 38 written eleven publications addressing various medical issues; and

39 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by outstanding 40 41 physicians such as Dr. Don Q. Mitchell, whose long and distinguished career has touched the lives of so many patients: 42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 43 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 44 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Dr. Don Q.
