HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 120  
(As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING DR. CHARLES H. BEADY, JR.,  
2 ON HIS OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS PRESIDENT OF THE PINEY WOODS COUNTRY  
3 LIFE SCHOOL.

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Charles H. Beady, Jr., has dedicated many years  
5 of outstanding service as the President of the Piney Woods Country  
6 Life School in Piney Woods, Mississippi; and

7 WHEREAS, born in Adel, Georgia, Dr. Beady's family moved to  
8 Flint, Michigan, where he graduated from Flint Northwestern High  
9 School and was the president of his graduating class; and

10 WHEREAS, after graduation from high school, Dr. Beady  
11 furthered his education at Michigan State University, where he  
12 received his undergraduate degree in advertising, his master of  
13 arts degree in urban counseling and his doctorate in counselor  
14 education; and

15 WHEREAS, while on leave from his assistant professorship in  
16 the School of Education at Morgan State University, Dr. Beady  
17 engaged in post-doctoral research at the Johns Hopkins University;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, later, Dr. Beady became the Senior Research  
20 Scientist at the Institute for Urban Research at Morgan State  
21 University and Research Affiliate at the Center for Social  
22 Organization of Schools at the Johns Hopkins University; and

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has combined his research and expertise in  
24 the area of academic motivation with his talents as a professional  
25 cartoonist to write, illustrate and produce slide-audio packages  
26 and other motivational materials which have been used by students,

27 teachers and parents around the country; and

28 WHEREAS, in August 1984, Dr. Beady came to the Piney Woods  
29 Country Life School and assumed the role of provost until the  
30 retirement of President James S. Wade in June of 1985, when he was  
31 appointed the school's third president; and

32 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady believes that a good teacher constitutes  
33 one who is knowledgeable and shows love, patience, dedication,  
34 resourcefulness and concern; and

35 WHEREAS, during his tenure as President of the Piney Woods  
36 Country Life School, Dr. Beady has successfully completed a \$3  
37 million capital campaign to renovate and double the size of the  
38 school's library; and

39 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady also has established the school's farm as  
40 an "open" classroom and as an integral part of the academic  
41 program, he was instrumental in constructing two new girls  
42 dormitories and has helped to increase the school's endowment from  
43 \$17.5 million to \$30 million in 15 years; and

44 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has received several awards throughout his  
45 successful career such as Michigan State University's 1995  
46 Distinguished Alumni Award and the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity's  
47 Humanitarian Award in 1996; and

48 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has gained national support of many  
49 celebrities, including Oprah Winfrey, Charles Schulz, Morgan  
50 Freeman, Denise Graves, Paul Warfield and Yolanda King; and

51 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
52 and pay special tribute to such an outstanding leader as Dr.  
53 Charles H. Beady, Jr., whose long and distinguished career has  
54 enriched the quality of education for students at the Piney Woods  
55 Country Life School:

56 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
57 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
58 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Dr. Charles H.  
59 Beady, Jr., on his outstanding service as President of the Piney  
60 Woods Country Life School and extend to him our heartiest wishes  
61 for success in all his future endeavors.
