Beady, Jr., has dedicated many years of outstanding service as the President of the Piney Woods Country 5 Life School in Piney Woods, Mississippi; and 6 7 WHEREAS, born in Adel, Georgia, Dr. Beady's family moved to Flint, Michigan, where he graduated from Flint Northwestern High 8 9 School and was the president of his graduating class; and WHEREAS, after graduation from high school, Dr. Beady 10 furthered his education at Michigan State University, where he 11 12 received his undergraduate degree in advertising, his master of 13 arts degree in urban counseling and his doctorate in counselor education; and 14 WHEREAS, while on leave from his assistant professorship in 15 the School of Education at Morgan State University, Dr. Beady 16 engaged in post-doctoral research at the Johns Hopkins University; 17 18 and WHEREAS, later, Dr. Beady became the Senior Research 19 20 Scientist at the Institute for Urban Research at Morgan State University and Research Affiliate at the Center for Social 2.1 Organization of Schools at the Johns Hopkins University; and 22 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has combined his research and expertise in 23 the area of academic motivation with his talents as a professional 24 cartoonist to write, illustrate and produce slide-audio packages 25

and other motivational materials which have been used by students,

- WHEREAS, in August 1984, Dr. Beady came to the Piney Woods
- 29 Country Life School and assumed the role of provost until the
- 30 retirement of President James S. Wade in June of 1985, when he was
- 31 appointed the school's third president; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady believes that a good teacher constitutes
- 33 one who is knowledgeable and shows love, patience, dedication,
- 34 resourcefulness and concern; and
- 35 WHEREAS, during his tenure as President of the Piney Woods
- 36 Country Life School, Dr. Beady has successfully completed a \$3
- 37 million capital campaign to renovate and double the size of the
- 38 school's library; and
- 39 WHEREAS, Dr. Beady also has established the school's farm as
- 40 an "open" classroom and as an integral part of the academic
- 41 program, he was instrumental in constructing two new girls
- 42 dormitories and has helped to increase the school's endowment from
- 43 \$17.5 million to \$30 million in 15 years; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has received several awards throughout his
- 45 successful career such as Michigan State University's 1995
- 46 Distinguished Alumni Award and the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity's
- 47 Humanitarian Award in 1996; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Beady has gained national support of many
- 49 celebrities, including Oprah Winfrey, Charles Schulz, Morgan
- 50 Freeman, Denise Graves, Paul Warfield and Yolanda King; and
- 51 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 52 and pay special tribute to such an outstanding leader as Dr.
- 53 Charles H. Beady, Jr., whose long and distinguished career has
- 54 enriched the quality of education for students at the Piney Woods
- 55 Country Life School:
