HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 123
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MR.
2 JEFF FEINBERG FOR BEING SELECTED AS INSTRUCTOR OF THE YEAR AT THE
3 COMMUNITY CAMPUS OF THE MISSISSIPPI GULF COAST COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Jeff Feinberg, a resident of Pascagoula,
5 Mississippi, has been selected as Instructor of the Year at the
6 Community Campus of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College

19 from the University of Southern Mississippi in 1998; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Feinberg has served in the United States Army
21 and currently serves as a Deacon, the Brotherhood Director and a
22 Sunday School teacher for the First Baptist Church in Moss Point;

24 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize and
25 commend such outstanding teachers as Mr. Jeff Feinberg, who has
26 dedicated his career to teaching the young people of this state:

28 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
