SIEGFRIED STEINBERGER FOR HIS MANY YEARS OF OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY SERVICE. 1 2 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Siegfried Steinberger has devoted many years of 4 community service to Simpson County, Mississippi; and 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Steinberger moved to Mississippi in 1963 to establish the Universal Manufacturing Company, which became the 6 7 largest employer in Simpson County and the second largest employer in the state, employing over 2,600 Mississippians at its peak; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Steinberger also started a wire mill in Gallman, Mississippi, and oversaw the acquisition and management of a 10 steel-slitting facility in Vicksburg, Mississippi; and 11 12 WHEREAS, throughout his career, Mr. Steinberger has held various leadership roles in many community organizations, 13 14 including the Director of the State of Mississippi Economic Counsel, the Chamber of Commerce Director for Mendenhall and 15 16 Magee, a Volunteer Manager of the Mendenhall Chamber of Commerce, a former President of the Mendenhall School Board and a former 17 President of the Lion's Club; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Steinberger also is a member of the Simpson 20 County Economic Foundation, the Red Cross, the Simpson County 21 Hospital Auxiliary, the Disabled American Veterans Chapter and the Mendenhall Masonic Lodge; and 2.2 WHEREAS, in addition to his involvement in community 23 24 organizations, Mr. Steinberger has been an active member of 25 St. Columbs Episcopal Church since 1963, where he has served as a Sunday School Teacher, Vestryman, Junior Warden, Senior Warden and 26
