HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 141
(As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE ALCORN STATE
2 UNIVERSITY DEBATE TEAM FOR WINNING THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
3 AFRICAN-AMERICAN HONORS PROGRAMS DEBATE TOURNAMENT.

4 WHEREAS, the Alcorn State University Debate Team won the
5 National Association of African-American Honors Programs Debate
6 Tournament at Bowie State University in Bowie, Maryland; and

7 WHEREAS, the National Association of African-American Honors
8 Programs is a consortium of programs at historically black
9 colleges and universities where students who comprise the group
10 are among some of the most academically talented in the nation;

12 WHEREAS, the Alcorn State Debate Team members who
13 participated in the tournament are April Smith, Aimee Jackson and
14 LaKeisha Costley and their advisor is Dr. Thomas Bolden; and

15 WHEREAS, the Alcorn State team defeated Hampton University
16 and Morehouse College in the first two rounds of competition,
17 leading them to the final competition where they defeated Bethune
18 Cookman College; and

19 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds it most appropriate to
20 recognize and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the
21 young people of this state, who are its future:
