| 7 | High School, where as a senior he averaged 24 points per game and |
| 8 | later played for Coach Denver Brackeen's team at East Central |
| 9 | Junior College; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, in 1965, Coach Chancellor earned a bachelor's degree |
| 11 | in math and physical education from Mississippi State University, |
| 12 | and in 1974, he received a master's degree in education from the |
| 13 | University of Mississippi; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, Coach Chancellor began his coaching career with |
| 15 | stops at Noxapater, Horn Lake and Harrison Central High Schools, |
| 16 | winning two state championships and two grand slams, compiling a |
| 17 | remarkable 638-191 record at the high school level; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, moving up to the college arena in 1978, Coach |
| 19 | Chancellor was named Head Coach of the Ole Miss Lady Rebels |
| 20 | Basketball Team and led the program to national prominence over a |
| 21 | 19-year career, including 14 NCAA tournament appearances, |
| 22 | finishing the 1991-1992 season with a perfect SEC record of 11-0 |
| 23 | and winning the SEC regular season championship; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, Coach Chancellor, who won the SEC Coach of the Year |

honor three times, posted a phenomenal career record of 439 wins

and only 154 losses, making his Lady Rebels the winningest program
