HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 146  
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DURANT HIGH SCHOOL  
2 LADY TIGERS BASKETBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THE CLASS 1A STATE  
3 CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, the Durant High School Lady Tigers Basketball Team  
5 finished the season with an outstanding record of 23 wins and only  
6 10 losses; and

7 WHEREAS, the Lady Tigers Basketball Team won the District 5,  
8 Class 1A Championship, the Class 1A State Championship and was  
9 runner-up in the South State Championship; and

10 WHEREAS, many individual honors have been bestowed among the  
11 players, including the selection of Ashley Howard to the All-South  
12 and All-State Tournament Teams, the naming of Monchel Howard to  
13 the All-South Tournament Team, the selection of Reta Bailey and

15 of Moneka Roby to the All-State Tournament Team and the selection  
16 of LaTasha Sumerall to the All-District, All-South State and  
17 All-State Tournament Teams and the 1998-1999 Most Valuable Player;

20 inspired by Head Coach Glendolyn Crowell and Assistant Coach  
21 Catherine McCrory, who have broadened the players knowledge of the

28 spirit and a high degree of sportsmanship, and their activities  
29 and attitude reflect great credit upon the individual players and  
30 their coaches and bring honor to Durant High School; and

31           WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
32 and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the young  
33 people of our state, who are its future:
