- 18 established the Riley Foundation, which has helped improve the
- 19 quality of life for individuals and the Meridian community as a
- 20 whole; and
- 21 WHEREAS, in January 1999, Dr. Riley, Chairman of the Riley
- 22 Foundation, announced grant awards totaling \$329,888.00 to allow
- 23 six Meridian and Lauderdale County organizations to implement
- 24 programs that promise long-term benefits for the area; and
- 25 WHEREAS, grant recipients include organizations such as the
- 26 Community of Hope Tutoring Program, Aldersgate Retirement

- 27 Community Youth Excitement Team, Inc., Care Lodge Domestic
