HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 154  
(As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 PORTER'S CHAPEL ACADEMY LADY EAGLES BASKETBALL TEAM FOR THEIR  
3 OUTSTANDING 1998-1999 SEASON.

4 WHEREAS, the Porter's Chapel Academy Lady Eagles Basketball  
5 Team finished the 1998-1999 season with an outstanding record of  
6 36 wins and only 3 losses; and

7 WHEREAS, throughout the Lady Eagles' season, they won several

22 All-Tournament Team the All-State Team and the MPSA Best Offensive  
23 Player; and the naming of K.K. Willis to the All-Conference  
24 Tournament Team, the All-Central State, the All-Tournament Team,  
25 the All-State Team; and

27 cooperative spirit and a high degree of sportsmanship, and their  
28 activities and attitude reflect great credit upon the individual  
29 players and their coach and bring honor to Porter's Chapel
