HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 158 (As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL

2 STUDENTS FOR THEIR COURAGE, BRAVERY AND HEROIC MEASURES AFTER

3 SURVIVING THE AMTRAK TRAIN WRECK.

WHEREAS, three young men from Clinton, Mississippi, displayed

- 5 courage and bravery after surviving the Amtrak train wreck on
- 6 March 15, 1999, in Bourbonnais, Illinois; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a group of Clinton students were on their way home
- 8 from a 10-day spring break skiing trip in Quebec, Canada, when the
- 9 Amtrak train careened off the tracks after slamming into a truck
- 10 loaded with steel bars at a crossing 50 miles south of Chicago,
- 11 Illinois; and
- 12 WHEREAS, after the crash, the train was silent only for a
- 13 moment before survivors screamed in fear during the horrible
- 14 tragedy; and
- WHEREAS, amidst the wreckage of the car the students were in,
- 16 Michael Freeman, a junior at Clinton High School, calmly and
- 17 carefully searched for an exit; and
- 18 WHEREAS, after opening a door, Michael Freeman found what
- 19 appeared to be power lines, so the young man continued his search
- 20 for another exit and found a window; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Michael Freeman built a ladder from broken chairs
- 22 while Caleb McNair and Jeffrey Sartor, also of Clinton, began
- 23 searching in the darkness for victims and assisting in their
- 24 rescue; and
- 25 WHEREAS, these three young men risked their lives in a
- 26 dangerous situation among smoke, fire and deadly destruction to

- 27 save the lives of others; and
- 28 WHEREAS, most of the Clinton students involved in the Amtrak
- 29 train wreck escaped serious harm with only bumps and bruises; and
- 30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 31 and commend heroism, especially when evidenced by the courageous
- 32 and brave young people of this state, who are its future:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 34 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 35 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend the Clinton students for their
- 36 courage, bravery and heroic measures after surviving the Amtrak
- 37 train wreck.
- 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
- 39 furnished to the Clinton students and members of the Capitol Press
