HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 163
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. NED BOUDREAUX UPON HIS
2 RETIREMENT AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GULF REGIONAL PLANNING
3 COMMISSION.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Ned Boudreaux has served as the Executive
5 Director of the Gulf Regional Planning Commission in Gulfport,
6 Mississippi, since 1992; and

7 WHEREAS, a native of Pass Christian, Mississippi, Mr.
8 Boudreaux who also served as acting director of the Commission
9 from 1974 to 1976, has advised elected officials in Hancock,
10 Harrison and Jackson counties on a variety of projects, including
11 road planning, growth and zoning, solid waste removal and a high
12 speed railroad corridor; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1968, Mr. Boudreaux began his career with the
14 Gulf Regional Planning Commission and has spent most of his time
15 there as a transportation planner; and

16 WHEREAS, for more than 25 years, Mr. Boudreaux has watched
17 the growth along the Gulf Coast area and played a vital role in
18 the development of new roads; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Boudreaux has been lovingly supported in all his
20 endeavors by his wife, Karen, and their children; and

21 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
22 and commend such outstanding Mississippians as Mr. Ned Boudreaux,
23 whose dedicated career has improved the quality of life and
24 business for all on the Mississippi Gulf Coast:

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
26 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING

27 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mr. Ned
