HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 172 (As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND 2 ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF MR. RICHARD BAXTER WILSON AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS FAMILY AND FRIENDS UPON HIS PASSING. 3 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard Baxter Wilson of Madison, Mississippi, departed this life on Monday, March 15, 1999, causing great loss 5 to his family and friends; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson, a former president of Mississippi Power and Light, was a native of Yazoo City and graduated from the 8 9 University of Mississippi in 1927; and WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson began his long and distinguished career 10 with Mississippi Power and Light in 1926 in Cleveland before 11 12 transferring to Jackson, where he served as president of the 13 company from 1954 to 1969 and chairman of the board until his retirement in 1976; and 14 WHEREAS, in addition to his responsibilities with Mississippi 15 Power and Light, Mr. Wilson served as chairman of the Jackson 16 Airport Authority, the Jackson Planning Board, the State National 17 Alliance of Businessmen and the Mississippi United States Savings 18 Bond Committee, and as the national vice president of the American 19

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson devoted much of his time and energy to 22 community service, having generously served as president of the 23 Jackson Chamber of Commerce and as a member of the Rotary Clubs of 24 Jackson and Cleveland, the Andrew Jackson Council of Boy Scouts of 25 America, the Southeastern Electric Exchange, the Beauvoir 26 Foundation, the University of Mississippi Alumni Association and

28 WHEREAS, in addition, Mr. Wilson actively served as a trustee 29 for many successful organizations and companies, such as Deposit Guaranty National Bank, Bellhaven College, the University of 30 31 Mississippi Alumni Association, the National Association of Electric Companies, the Edison Electric Institute, the 32 Southeastern Electric Exchange, Mississippi Economic Council, 33 Magna Corporation, Standard Life Insurance Company, the 34 Mississippi Agricultural and Industrial Board and Southern 35 Research Institute; and 36

37 WHEREAS, in recognition of his outstanding leadership and 38 countless contributions throughout the state, an endowed 39 fellowship at the University of Mississippi was established in 40 honor of Mr. Wilson; and

41 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson was the recipient of many honorable 42 awards, including the First Federal Award presented for his 43 distinguished service to the state; and

WHEREAS, a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church in
Jackson, Mr. Wilson served as a deacon for almost 50 years; and
WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson is survived by his two children, Richard
Baxter Wilson, Jr., and Miriam Weems, and two grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize and pay special tribute to such outstanding Mississippians as Mr. Richard Baxter Wilson, a remarkable citizen who dedicated his life to the furthering development of this state and improving the quality of life for all Mississippians:
