HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 18
(As Adopted by House)

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE CHOCTAW
2 CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL WARRIORS BASKETBALL TEAM FOR ITS OUTSTANDING
3 1998-1999 SEASON AND FOR WINNING THE STATE 2A CHAMPIONSHIP.
