HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 23
(As Adopted by House)

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE COLUMBIA HIGH
2 SCHOOL WILDCATS FOOTBALL TEAM FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING 1998 SEASON
3 AND FOR WINNING THE CLASS 4A SOUTH STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, winning the Class 4A South State Championship, the
5 Columbia High School Wildcats Football Team finished the regular
6 season with a record of 12 wins and only three losses; and

7 WHEREAS, many individual honors have been bestowed among the
8 players, including the selection of Dwayne Moree, Chad Porter,
9 Todd Harmon, Rico Marks, T.J. Jackson, Jasper Loftin and Antoiuine
10 Brown for All-District Honors; the naming of Jay Rayborn, Thad
11 Akens and Michael Bradshaw as All-District Honorable Mention; the
12 selection of Nick Davis as the Most Outstanding Linebacker; the
13 naming of Steve Odom as Most Outstanding Back; the selection of
14 Anthony Abram as Most Outstanding Defensive Back; and the naming
15 of Donovan Walker as the Most Valuable Player for District 7-4A,
16 to the All-State Second Team and the Mississippi-Alabama All-Star

18 WHEREAS, the Wildcats have been superbly coached and inspired
19 by Head Coach Joey Porter and Assistant Coaches Tim Gatlin, Phelix
20 Shoemaker, Steve Harmon and John McElroy, who have broadened the

24 spirit and a high degree of sportsmanship, and their activities
25 and attitude reflect great credit upon the individual players and
26 their coach and bring honor to Columbia High School; and

29 especially when evidenced by the young people of our state, who
30 are its future:
