HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 24
(As Adopted by House)

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING REVEREND ED LOVELEST (L.L.) LOGAN FOR
2 HIS MANY YEARS OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE.

3 WHEREAS, Reverend Ed Lovelest (L.L.) Logan has preached in
4 various churches throughout the State of Mississippi for over 50
5 years; and

6 WHEREAS, Reverend Logan was born on August 4, 1911, to Lewis
7 and Sarah Logan and accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior
8 at the early age of nine; and

9 WHEREAS, Reverend Logan's mother bought him a Bible and would
10 diligently read to him, and as a child, he would go behind the
11 barn and pray very loud; and

12 WHEREAS, throughout his long and distinguished career,
13 Reverend Logan has ministered in several churches, including: Oak
14 Grove Missionary Baptist Church from 1947 to 1955 and from 1987 to
15 the present; Spring Hill Missionary Baptist Church from 1945 to
16 1953; Beth Salem Missionary Baptist Church from 1953 to 1983;
17 Callahan Missionary Baptist Church from 1954 to 1966; Shiloh
18 Missionary Baptist Church from 1962 to the present; Antioch
19 Missionary Baptist Church from 1957 to the present; and Pleasant
20 Ridge Missionary Baptist Church from 1958 to the present; and

21 WHEREAS, Reverend Logan has held many leadership roles in the
22 Mt. Olive District Association, including Moderator, District Dean
23 and State Dean, and he currently serves as Moderator Emeritus; and

24 WHEREAS, Reverend Logan was lovingly supported in all his
25 endeavors by his late wife, Catherine Gandy Logan, and continues
26 to be supported by their children, Eddie Logan, Bessie Logan

27 Malone, Mae Pearl Logan Bowden and Queen Esther Logan Long; and
28 WHEREAS, Reverend Logan, a loving father and devoted family
29 man also raised his nephew, Tommie Logan, who is now deceased; and
30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
31 the State of Mississippi to recognize and commend such outstanding
32 Mississippians as Reverend Logan, who has dedicated his life to
33 teaching others about Jesus Christ:
