1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING REPRESENTATIVE CHARLIE WILLIAMS FOR 2 HIS EXCEPTIONAL LEGISLATIVE CAREER AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR 3 HIS MANY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PEOPLE OF MISSISSIPPI. 4 WHEREAS, Representative Charlie Williams, a lifelong resident of Tate County, has served District 8 in the Mississippi House of 5 Representatives since being elected in 1975; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Representative Williams, the son of the late E.M. 8 (Bill) Williams and Mary McGinnis Williams, was born November 28, 9 1944, and attended Senatobia City Schools; and WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, Representative 10 Williams attended Northwest Mississippi Community College and 11 12 graduated from the University of Mississippi, where he was 13 president of Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity; and WHEREAS, Representative Williams, an All-SEC baseball player 14 at Ole Miss, still holds the school record with 31 stolen bases in 15 a 31 game season, and in 1996, he was inducted into the Ole Miss 16 Alumni Association's Athletic Hall of Fame; and 17 WHEREAS, Representative Williams, Chairman of the House Ways 18 and Means Committee since 1992, is a member of the House Insurance 19 20 Committee, the Oil, Gas and Other Minerals Committee, and the Management, as well as the Joint Executive Contingent Fund 21 Committee, the Joint Investigation of State Offices Committee and 22 the Legislative Budget Committee; and 23 24 WHEREAS, during his legislative career, Representative 25 Williams has been selected to serve on numerous special committees, including a select committee on education in 1990, the 26

30 WHEREAS, a leader in both national and regional legislative 31 circles, in 1998, Representative Williams was named Chairman of 32 the Council of State Governments, a national nonpartisan 33 organization founded in 1933 to promote excellence in state 34 government; and

35 WHEREAS, Representative Williams is a recognized expert on 36 gaming industry legislation and played a major role in passage of 37 legislation involving the state tax structure, tax equalization, 38 the widely acclaimed 1982 Education Reform Act, the landmark 39 Education Improvement Act of 1992 and the 1987 Four-Lane Highway 40 Program; and

WHEREAS, the owner of Charlie Williams Insurance Agency, 41 Representative Williams is a member of the First United Methodist 42 Church in Senatobia, the Diabetes Foundation of Mississippi 43 44 Advisory Board and the Special Olympics of Mississippi; and WHEREAS, known by his colleagues for his dedication, 45 46 organizational skills and hard work, Representative Williams has been a strong advocate of legislation dealing with economic 47 48 development, highways, agriculture, rural opportunities and all
