1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IF A LEGAL HOLIDAY FALLS ON A SATURDAY, THE FRIDAY BEFORE SHALL BE A LEGAL HOLIDAY; TO AMEND SECTION 25-1-97, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	3-3-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2)
9	of this section, the following are declared to be legal holidays,
LO	viz: the first day of January (New Year's Day); the third Monday
L1	of January (Robert E. Lee's birthday and Dr. Martin Luther King,
L2	Jr.'s birthday); the third Monday of February (Washington's
L3	birthday); the last Monday of April (Confederate Memorial Day);
L4	the last Monday of May (National Memorial Day and Jefferson Davis'
L5	birthday); the fourth day of July (Independence Day); the first
L6	Monday of September (Labor Day); the eleventh day of November
L7	(Armistice or Veterans' Day); the day fixed by proclamation by the
L8	Governor of Mississippi as a day of Thanksgiving, which shall be
L9	fixed to correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the
20	United States (Thanksgiving Day); and the twenty-fifth day of
21	December (Christmas Day). <u>If a legal holiday falls on Saturday,</u>
22	the Friday before shall be a legal holiday and if a legal
23	holiday * * * falls on Sunday, * * * the * * * following \underline{Monday}
24	shall be a legal holiday.
25	(2) In lieu of any one (1) legal holiday provided for in
26	subsection (1) of this section, with the exception of the third

- 28 birthday), the governing authorities of any municipality or county
- 29 may declare, by order spread upon its minutes, Mardi Gras Day or
- 30 any one (1) other day during the year, to be a legal holiday.
- 31 (3) August 16 is declared to be Elvis Aron Presley Day in
- 32 recognition and appreciation of Elvis Aron Presley's many
- 33 contributions, international recognition and the rich legacy left
- 34 to us by Elvis Aron Presley. This day shall be a day of
- 35 recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal
- 36 holiday.
- 37 (4) May 8 is declared to be Hernando de Soto Day in
- 38 recognition, observation and commemoration of Hernando de Soto,
- 39 who led the first and most imposing expedition ever made by
- 40 Europeans into the wilds of North America and the State of
- 41 Mississippi, and in further recognition of the Spanish explorer's
- 42 187-day journey from the Tombigbee River basin on our state's
- 43 eastern boundary, westward to the place of discovery of the
- 44 Mississippi River on May 8, 1541. This day shall be a day of
- 45 commemoration, recognition and observation of Hernando de Soto and
- 46 European exploration and shall not be recognized as a legal
- 47 holiday.
- 48 (5) Insofar as possible, Armistice Day shall be observed by
- 49 appropriate exercises in all the public schools in the State of
- 50 Mississippi at the eleventh hour in the morning of the eleventh
- 51 day of the eleventh month of the year.
- 52 SECTION 2. Section 25-1-97, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 53 amended as follows:
- 54 25-1-97. The <u>Department of Finance and Administration</u> is
- 55 hereby authorized and empowered to fix the hours for the opening
- 56 and closing of public offices of the state commensurate with the
- 57 seasons of the year. The business hours of all of the state
- 58 public offices, departments, boards, commissions and agencies
- 59 shall be uniform, and the offices shall be open for business eight
- 60 (8) hours per day Monday through Friday of each week except state
- 61 holidays * * *. Nothing contained in this section shall be
- 62 construed to prohibit any office, department, board, commission or
- 63 agency to conduct essential business outside of the regular
- 64 business day hours when the executive head or governing body deems

- 65 it necessary. * * *
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 67 and after its passage.
