## SENATE BILL NO. 2066

AN ACT TO CODIFY THE OFFENSE OF ALLOWING A DOG TO BITE OR ATTACK A PERSON ON PROPERTY OTHER THAN THAT OF THE OWNER; TO ENACT 1 2 3 LEVELS OF OFFENSES; TO SPECIFY PUNISHMENTS THEREFOR; TO AMEND 4 SECTION 41-53-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 8 41-53-15, Mississippi Code of 1972: <u>41-53-15.</u> (1) It shall be unlawful for the owner of a dog 9 to fail to take reasonable steps to restrain the dog if: 10 11 (a) The dog enters property other than the property of the dog's owner; and 12 13 (b) While on property other than the property of the 14 dog's owner, the dog bites or attacks another person resulting in unprovoked bodily injury to the other person. 15 (2) Where a violation under this section does not result in 16 the death or serious bodily injury of a person, the offender shall 17 be fined in a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) upon 18 conviction for a first offense; upon conviction for a second or 19 subsequent such offense, the offender shall be fined in a sum not 20 21 to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) and imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. 22 (3) Where the violation results in the death of a person, 23 the violation shall be a felony, and upon conviction thereof, the 24 offender shall be sentenced to the custody of the State Department 25 of Corrections for a term not to exceed ten (10) years. 26

(4) Where the violation results in serious bodily injury to

28 a person, the violation shall be a felony, and upon conviction 29 thereof, the offender shall be sentenced to the custody of the 30 State Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) 31 years.

32 (5) This section shall not apply where the dog is owned by 33 the United States, an agency of the United States or another 34 governmental entity if the dog is engaged in assisting in the 35 performance of law enforcement or military duties.

36 SECTION 2. Section 41-53-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 37 amended as follows:

Except as provided in Section 41-53-15, the 38 41-53-13. 39 failure or refusal of any person to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor, and the 40 offender shall, on conviction thereof, be fined for the first 41 offense in a sum not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00) and for the 42 43 second offense in a sum not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) 44 and for the third offense a sum not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), together with all costs. It shall be the duty of the 45 46 sheriffs, conservation officers and all peace officers of the counties and municipalities of Mississippi to enforce this 47 chapter. It shall be the duty of the county attorneys and 48 district attorneys of this state to prosecute all violators of 49 50 this chapter.

51 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 52 and after July 1, 1999.
