- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Whenever there is any discussion in any
- 8 public school class or assembly of conduct that is unlawful under
- 9 the laws of the State of Mississippi, the teacher or school
- 10 employee facilitating the discussion shall inform the students
- 11 that the conduct being discussed is unlawful. No teacher or other
- 12 school employee shall facilitate a classroom or assembly
- 13 discussion of unlawful conduct in any manner that may encourage
- 14 students to participate in such unlawful conduct.
- 15 (2) If any teacher or other school employee is determined to
- 16 have violated this section, the local school board, in its
- 17 discretion, may take appropriate disciplinary action against the
- 18 teacher or school employee. A violation of this section, in the
- 19 discretion of the school board, may constitute good cause for the
- 20 dismissal or suspension of a teacher or other licensed employee
- 21 under Section 37-9-59.
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 1999.
