The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the University of 9 Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of defraying the 10 11 expenses of research on Alzheimer's disease, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 12 13 2000.....\$ 180,000.00. 14 SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 15 16 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 17 18 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 20 21 and after July 1, 1999.
