SENATE BILL NO. 2105

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS TO THE
2 UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF RESEARCH ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE FOR
4 FISCAL YEAR 2000. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE
5 OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the University of
10 Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of defraying the
11 expenses of research on Alzheimer's disease, for the fiscal year
12 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30,
13 2000..... \$ 180,000.00.

14 SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
15 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
16 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
17 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
18 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
19 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after July 1, 1999.
