7	SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as

9	5-1-44. Beginning with the 2000 Regular Session of the
10	Legislature of the State of Mississippi, the Chairman of the
11	Senate Appropriations Committee and the Chairman of the House
12	Appropriations Committee shall receive an annual salary in an
13	amount equal to Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). The salary
14	provided for the chairmen under this section shall be in addition
15	to the compensation and expense allowance established for members
16	of the Legislature under Section 5-1-41.
17	SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
18	is hereby directed to submit this act, immediately upon approval
19	by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to
20	a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the
21	United States District Court for the District of Columbia in
22	accordance with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965,
23	as amended and extended.
24	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting

Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
