1 2 3	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE COMPENSATION OF THE FULL-TIME LEGAL ASSISTANTS EMPLOYED BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25-3-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	25-3-35. (1) The annual salaries of the following judges
8	are fixed as follows, to begin at the commencement of the next
9	term of office immediately succeeding the existing term:
10	Chief Justice of the Supreme Court \$100,900.00
11	Presiding Justice of the Supreme Court 98,900.00
12	Associate Justices of the Supreme Court, each 98,300.00
13	However, in addition to their present official duties, there
14	are imposed upon the Supreme Court Justices the extra duties of
15	making a special study of existing laws and reporting to each
16	regular session of the Legislature such constructive suggestions
17	as they may deem necessary for the improvement of the
18	administration of justice, and of advising and counseling with the
19	State Librarian in the selection of law books for purchase and use
20	in the State Law Library, advising with the librarian thereof upon
21	the removal from the library of any books which may be the least
22	frequently used, and for the placing of same in a convenient
23	location so as to provide additional space for such books and
24	other current publications which may be more frequently used or
25	called for. For such extra services each justice, from and after
26	the effective date of Laws, 1997, Chapter 577, shall receive a sum
27	sufficient when added to the present salaries of the justices to

- (c) The annual salary of full-time legal assistants who 88
- have actively practiced law for more than six (6) years, but less 89
- 90 than ten (10) years, shall not be less than Sixty-seven Thousand
- 91 Five Hundred Dollars (\$67,500.00) nor more than Seventy-five
- Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), as established by the District 92
- 93 Attorney.
- (d) The annual salary of full-time legal assistants who 94
- 95 have actively practiced law in excess of ten (10) years shall not
- 96 be less than Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) and may,
- in the discretion of the district attorney, include an additional 97
- 98 amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each year the legal
- 99 assistant has practiced law in excess of ten (10) years; provided,
