SENATE BILL NO. 2157

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-9-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO COMPENSATE MENTOR TEACHERS 3 FOR ADDITIONAL DUTIES PERFORMED UNDER THE BEGINNING TEACHER SUPPORT PROGRAM, TO GRANT ADDITIONAL RELEASE TIME FOR SUCH MENTOR 4 5 TEACHERS AND TO EMPLOY SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS FOR ASSUMING THE REGULAR TEACHING DUTIES OF MENTOR TEACHERS; AND FOR RELATED 6 7 PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 37-9-211, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows: 37-9-211. (1) The selection, nature and extent of duties of 11 mentor teachers shall be determined by the school district. The 12 following guidelines shall apply: 13 14 (a) No teacher shall be designated as a mentor teacher 15 unless willing to perform in that role; (b) No mentor teacher shall participate in the 16 17 evaluation of beginning teachers; (c) Each mentor teacher shall complete successfully a 18 training workshop provided or approved by the Mississippi Teacher 19 20 Center prior to participating in the beginning teacher support 21 program; 22 (d) If a mentor teacher receives additional release time to support a beginning teacher, it is expected that the total 23 24 workload of other teachers regularly employed by the school 25 district should not increase in any substantial manner. (2) Any local school district shall be authorized (a) to 26 compensate mentor teachers from any available funds for additional 27 duties to support a beginning teacher which are performed after 28

- 29 regular school hours, (b) to grant additional release time to
- 30 mentor teachers for additional duties to support a beginning
- 31 teacher which are performed after regular school hours, and (c) to
- 32 <u>employ and compensate substitute teachers from any available funds</u>
- 33 for assuming the regular teaching duties of mentor teachers who
- 34 are participating in the beginning teacher program.
- 35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 1999.
