## SENATE BILL NO. 2183

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- SECTION 1. Section 37-3-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-3-9. (1) \* \* \* From and after July 1, 1984, there shall
- 10 be a State Superintendent of Public Education who shall be
- 11 appointed by the State Board of Education, with the advice and
- 12 consent of the Senate, and serve at the board's will and pleasure.
- 13 He shall be the chief administrative officer for the State
- 14 Department of Education and shall administer the department in
- 15 accordance with the policies established by the State Board of
- 16 Education. He shall receive such compensation as shall be
- 17 prescribed by the State Board of Education. The State
- 18 Superintendent of Public Education shall have at least a master's
- 19 degree in any field and a minimum of five (5) years' experience in
- 20 administration in the educational field.
- 21 (2) The state superintendent shall give bond in the penalty
- of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), with sureties to be
- 23 approved by the Governor, conditioned according to law. Said bond
- 24 when approved shall be filed and recorded in the office of the
- 25 Secretary of State.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 1999.
