SENATE BILL NO. 2236

1 2 3 4 5 6	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SALARY OF ADDITIONAL DEPUTY SHERIFFS WHO ARE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED FOR NARCOTICS ENFORCEMENT SHALL BE FUNDED FROM THE PROCEEDS OF FINES COLLECTED BY THE COUNTY FROM CONVICTIONS UNDER THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 19-25-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	19-25-13. The sheriff shall, at the July meeting of the
11	board of supervisors, submit a budget of estimated expenses of his
12	office for the ensuing fiscal year beginning October 1 in such
13	form as shall be prescribed by the Director of the State
14	Department of Audit. The board shall examine this proposed budget
15	and determine the amount to be expended by the sheriff in the
16	performance of his duties for the fiscal year and may increase or
17	reduce said amount as it deems necessary and proper.
18	The budget shall include amounts for compensating the
19	deputies and other employees of the sheriff's office, for
20	insurance providing protection for the sheriff and his deputies in
21	case of disability, death and other similar coverage, for travel
22	and transportation expenses of the sheriff and deputies, for
23	feeding prisoners and inmates of the county jail, and for such
24	other expenses as may be incurred in the performance of the duties
25	of the office of sheriff. In addition, the budget shall include
26	amounts for the payment of premiums on bonds and insurance for the

sheriff and his deputies which, in the opinion of the board of

supervisors, are deemed necessary to protect the interests of the

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29 county or the sheriff and his deputies. Such amounts may include 30 official bonds and any bonds required of his deputies by the sheriff; liability insurance; insurance against false arrest 31 32 charges; insurance against false imprisonment charges; theft, fire 33 and other hazards insurance; and hospitalization insurance as provided for in Sections 25-15-101 and 25-15-103. The board may 34 authorize the reimbursement of the sheriff and deputies for the 35 use of privately owned automobiles or other motor vehicles in the 36 performance of official duties at the rate provided by law for 37 state officers and employees or may authorize the purchase by the 38 39 sheriff of such motor vehicles and such equipment as may be needed for operation of the sheriff's office, such vehicles and equipment 40 41 to be owned by the county. In counties which have elected to purchase the motor vehicles and such equipment for the operation 42 of the sheriff's office, if a sheriff or deputy shall be required 43 44 in the performance of his official duties, in the event of an 45 emergency, to use his privately owned automobile or other motor vehicle, the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, 46 authorize the reimbursement for such use at the rate per mile 47 48 provided by law for state officers and employees. This shall not be construed as giving an officer a choice of whether to use his 49 50 own or the county's vehicle but shall be construed so as not to penalize an officer who must use his own vehicle because the 51 county's vehicle was not available. 52 53 In any county having an additional deputy sheriff who is specifically designated for narcotics enforcement, the salary of 54 55 the deputy shall be funded from the proceeds of fines collected by the county from convictions of violations of the Uniform 56 Controlled Substances Law. 57 58 The board of supervisors may acquire one or more credit cards 59 which may be used by the sheriff and his deputies to pay expenses 60 incurred by them when traveling in or out of state in the performance of their official duties. The chancery clerk or 61 62 county purchase clerk shall maintain complete records of all 63 credit card numbers and all receipts and other documents relating to the use of such credit cards. The sheriff shall furnish 64 receipts for the use of such credit cards each month to the 65

66 chancery clerk or purchase clerk who shall submit a written report

67 monthly to the board of supervisors, which report shall include an

- 68 itemized list of all expenditures and use of the credit cards for
- 69 the month, and such expenditures may be allowed for payment by the
- 70 county in the same manner as other items on the claims docket.
- 71 The issuance of a credit card to a sheriff or his deputy under the
- 72 provisions of this section shall not be construed to authorize
- 73 such sheriff or deputy sheriff to use such credit card to make any
- 74 expenditure which is not otherwise authorized by law.
- 75 The board of supervisors is hereby authorized and empowered,
- 76 in its discretion, to appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed Four
- 77 Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) annually as a clothing allowance to each
- 78 plainclothes investigator employed by the sheriff's office of such
- 79 county. The board of supervisors of any county bordering on the
- 80 Gulf of Mexico and having a population of more than thirty-one
- 81 thousand seven hundred (31,700) but less than thirty-one thousand
- 82 eight hundred (31,800) according to the 1990 Federal Census may
- 83 appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed Four Hundred Dollars
- 84 (\$400.00) annually as a clothing allowance to the administrator of
- 85 the county jail.
- The board of supervisors shall, at its first meeting of each
- 87 quarter beginning on October 1, January 1, April 1 and July 1,
- 88 appropriate a lump sum for the sheriff for the expenses of his
- 89 office during the current quarter. The quarterly appropriation
- 90 shall be one-fourth (1/4) of the amount approved in the annual
- 91 budget unless the sheriff requests a different amount. Except in
- 92 case of emergency, as provided in the county budget law, the
- 93 appropriation for the quarter beginning in October of the last
- 94 year of the sheriff's term shall not exceed one-fourth (1/4) of
- 95 the annual budget.
- The sheriff shall file a report of all expenses of his office
- 97 incurred during the preceding month with the board of supervisors
- 98 for approval at its regular monthly meeting in a form to be

- 99 prescribed by the Director of the State Department of Audit, and
- 100 upon filing thereof, and approval by the board, the clerk of the
- 101 board shall issue warrants in payment thereof but not to exceed
- 102 the budget appropriation for that quarter. Any appropriated funds
- 103 which are unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in
- 104 the county general fund.
- The budget for the sheriff's office may be revised at any
- 106 regular meeting by the board of supervisors. Upon recommendation
- 107 of the sheriff, the board may at any regular meeting make
- 108 supplemental appropriations to the sheriff's office.
- 109 Any fees previously required to be paid by a sheriff shall be
- 110 paid by the board of supervisors by including the estimates
- 111 therefor in the sheriff's budget. All fees and charges for
- 112 services heretofore collected by sheriffs shall be collected by
- 113 said sheriff and paid monthly into the general fund of the
- 114 concerned county. However, any fees heretofore collected by such
- 115 sheriffs from the county shall not be paid.
- 116 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 117 and after October 1, 1999.
