4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Any health, accident or sickness insurance policy
6	or hospital, medical service contract or policy which takes effect
7	on or after July 1, 1999, shall provide for reimbursement of
8	anesthesia expenses, hospital expenses and physician expenses
9	associated with any inpatient/outpatient hospital dental procedure
10	where:
11	(a) Such expense is covered under such contract or
12	policy; and
13	(b) The procedure is performed on a minor eight (8)
14	years of age or younger and cannot be safely performed in a dental
15	office setting.
16	The benefit provided for by this section shall be subject to
17	the same annual deductibles or co-insurance established for all
18	other covered benefits within a given plan, policy or contract.
19	Private third-party payors may not reduce or eliminate coverage
20	due to the requirements of this section. Nothing contained herein
21	shall be construed as applying to medical assistance programs
22	funded with state and federal funds, if such programs require
23	provision of services as medically necessary. When services
24	defined in this section are provided by a dentist acting within
25	the lawful scope of his license, benefits shall be provided at the

same levels and under the same terms whether provided by a
