- SECTION 1. Section 99-5-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 99-5-15. It is the duty of the sheriff or other officer
- 10 having custody of such defendant, upon his compliance with the
- 11 order of the committing court or officer, to release him from
- 12 custody; and he shall approve the sureties on the bond, except
- 13 admitted and authorized fidelity and surety insurance companies
- 14 and professional bail agents, acting as surety, and for that
- 15 purpose may examine them on oath, or take their affidavit in
- 16 writing, and may administer such oath.
