## SENATE BILL NO. 2273

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-41-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 GRANT TO A SCHOOL BOARD OR SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION STANDING TO 3 SEEK A WRIT OF MANDAMUS TO COMPEL PERFORMANCE OF A LAWFUL DUTY IN 4 MATTERS AFFECTING THE OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OVER WHICH 5 THEY MAY PRESIDE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 11-41-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

11-41-1. (1) On the complaint of the state, by its Attorney 9 10 General or a district attorney, in any matter affecting the public 11 interest, or on the complaint of any private person who is interested, the judgment shall be issued by the circuit court, 12 13 commanding any inferior tribunal, corporation, board, officer, or 14 person to do or not to do an act the performance or omission of which the law specially enjoins as a duty resulting from an 15 office, trust, or station, where there is not a plain, adequate, 16 and speedy remedy in the ordinary course of law. All procedural 17 aspects of this action shall be governed by the Mississippi Rules 18 of Civil Procedure. 19 (2) In any matter affecting the operation of the school 20

21 district over which they preside, the duly appointed or elected 22 school board or school superintendent shall have the same 23 authority as is conferred on the Attorney General or district 24 attorney by subsection (1) of this section.

25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after its passage.
