- 6 SECTION 1. Section 39-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 39-1-1. (1) There shall be a State Library which shall
- 9 render law library services to the Supreme Court and other state
- 10 courts, to state officials and to the general public.
- 11 (2) The State Library shall be under the supervision and
- 12 control of the Mississippi Supreme Court and the court shall be
- 13 empowered to promulgate policies and procedures necessary to the
- 14 efficient operation of the Library.
- 15 (3) The State Librarian shall be appointed as provided by
- 16 <u>Section 106, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, and shall be</u>
- 17 <u>compensated as a member of the staff of the Supreme Court.</u>

- 19 and after the date that the amendments to the Mississippi
- 20 Constitution of 1890 as proposed by Senate Concurrent Resolution
