SENATE BILL NO. 2307

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 MAKE PROVISION FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF THE STATE  
3 LAW LIBRARIAN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE  
4 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 39-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
7 amended as follows:

8 39-1-1. (1) There shall be a State Library which shall  
9 render law library services to the Supreme Court and other state  
10 courts, to state officials and to the general public.

11 (2) The State Library shall be under the supervision and  
12 control of the Mississippi Supreme Court and the court shall be  
13 empowered to promulgate policies and procedures necessary to the  
14 efficient operation of the Library.

15 (3) The State Librarian shall be appointed as provided by  
16 Section 106, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, and shall be  
17 compensated as a member of the staff of the Supreme Court.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
19 and after the date that the amendments to the Mississippi  
20 Constitution of 1890 as proposed by Senate Concurrent Resolution  
21 No. 516, 1999 Regular Session, is certified by the Secretary of  
22 State as having been ratified by the people.
