BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-116, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 47-5-116. (1) \* \* \* The term "Biddle guard" \* \* \* means a 9 device or partition installed in a vehicle operated by a law 10 enforcement officer which separates the front and rear passenger 11 compartments. 12 13 (2) It is unlawful to transport a prisoner who is \* \* \* committed to the Department of Corrections \* \* \* in a vehicle 14 which is not equipped with a secure Biddle guard \* \* \*. 15 (3) The commissioner \* \* \*, sheriff, or chief law 16 enforcement officer who is responsible for a vehicle in which a 17 prisoner is transported in violation of this section shall \* \* \* 18 19 be liable personally for any damages arising from injuries to persons or property caused by a prisoner who \* \* \* escapes while 20 being transported in violation of this section. 21 22 (4) This section does not \* \* \* apply to any vehicle used by a correctional officer for \* \* \* transporting prisoners \* \* \* on 23 the grounds of <u>a correctional</u> facility under the jurisdiction of 24 the \* \* \* department \* \* \*. 25 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 27
