SENATE BILL NO. 2332 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-116, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO TRANSPORT ANY PRISONER COMMITTED TO THE 2 3 CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IN A VEHICLE WITHOUT A BIDDLE GUARD; TO IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR 4 5 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-116, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 47-5-116. (1) * * * The term "Biddle guard" * * * means a 9 device or partition installed in a vehicle operated by a law 10 enforcement officer which separates the front and rear passenger 11 compartments. 12 13 (2) It is unlawful to transport a prisoner who is * * * committed to the Department of Corrections * * * in a vehicle 14 which is not equipped with a secure Biddle guard * * *. 15 (3) The Commissioner of Corrections, sheriff or chief law 16 enforcement officer who is responsible for a vehicle in which any 17 transportation in violation of this section occurs shall * * * be 18 19 assessed a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 20 (\$1,500.00) which shall be collected by the Attorney General and 21 paid into the State Treasury. 22 (4) This section does not * * * apply to any vehicle used by a correctional officer for * * * transporting prisoners * * * on 23 the grounds of <u>a correctional</u> facility under the jurisdiction of 24 the * * * department * * *, to any vehicle used by a field officer 25 26 of the Department of Corrections when taking a prisoner into the custody of the Department of Corrections or to any vehicle used to 27

- 29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 20 and often July 1 1000
