SENATE BILL NO. 2336  
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL  
2 FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR THE PURPOSE  
3 OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 1999  
4 AND 2000.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore  
7 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of  
10 Environmental Quality for the purpose of defraying the expenses of  
11 the department for the period beginning upon passage and through  
12 June 30, 2000..... \$ 650,000.00.

13 SECTION 2. This additional appropriation is made for the  
14 purpose of providing Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars  
15 (\$350,000.00) to support on-going efforts to determine the total  
16 maximum daily loads (TMDL) of pollution of impaired waters and  
17 related expenses in the Surface Water Quality Program, and Three  
18 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) to support the Air Quality  
19 105 Program for work in the non-attainment areas of DeSoto County  
20 and the Gulf Coast.

21 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
22 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds

23 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal  
24 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
25 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers  
26 in the manner provided by law.

27 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
28 and after its passage and through June 30, 2000.
