The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks 9 may provide handicapped hunters reasonable access to hunting areas 10 11 in public wildlife management areas under its jurisdiction. The 12 Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks shall promulgate rules and regulations for reasonable access and include a definition of 13 14 "handicapped hunters" as used in this section. The department 15 shall allow handicapped hunters to use existing roads in wildlife 16 management areas during hunting season. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 17

18 and after July 1, 1999.
