## SENATE BILL NO. 2367

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PONTOTOC, MISSISSIPPI, TO ACQUIRE AND ASSUME THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PRIMROSE 2 WATER ASSOCIATION AND TO ASSUME ALL THE LIABILITIES, OBLIGATIONS, 4 ASSETS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SUCH ASSOCIATION; TO 5 AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PONTOTOC TO OPERATE ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM FOR A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN FIVE MILES FROM THE CORPORATE 6 LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PONTOTOC IN ORDER TO OPERATE THE WATER 7 8 SYSTEM WITHIN THE AREA PRESENTLY SERVED BY THE PRIMROSE WATER 9 SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE 10 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. (1) The City of Pontotoc, Mississippi, acting by 13 and through its governing authorities, is hereby authorized and 14 empowered to acquire the Primrose Water System and to assume the operation and maintenance of the Primrose Water Association; and, 15 16 in connection therewith, such governing authorities are vested 17 with the power to assume all liabilities, obligations, assets, duties and responsibilities of such association. The city shall 18 have such powers and authority concerning the association and its 19

(2) Any indebtedness incurred by the City of Pontotoc as a result of the exercise of the authority granted to it in subsection (1) of this section shall not constitute a debt within the meaning of any statutory limitation as to the amount of debt which may be incurred by the municipality.

SECTION 2. (1) (a) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing authorities of the City of Pontotoc, Mississippi, may, in their discretion, construct, expand, operate and maintain the

- 48 construed as an exemption of Section 77-3-1 et seq., Mississippi
- 49 Code of 1972, as to the requirements of obtaining a Certificate of
- 50 Public Convenience and Necessity, the jurisdiction of the Public
- 51 Service Commission to regulate rates or any other provision of
- 52 law.
- 53 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
