SENATE BILL NO. 2374

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO BE KNOWN AS THE "FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY
RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION PROGRAM" TO PURCHASE THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY SEGMENTS ON ROUTES THAT
ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE EXISTING FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY PROGRAM; TO
ESTABLISH THE CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY ACQUIRED
UNDER THIS PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY
THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Transportation shall
- 11 establish a program to be known as the "Four-lane Right-of-way
- 12 Acquisition Program" to purchase rights-of-way for the
- 13 construction of additional four-lane highway segments on routes
- 14 that are not designated in Section 65-3-97.
- 15 (2) Acquisitions of rights-of-way under the program
- 16 established under this section shall be made along routes
- 17 projected by the Department of Transportation to have a
- 18 significant future need for the location of a four-lane highway.
- 19 The determination by the Department of Transportation shall be
- 20 based upon public necessity and public safety, present and future
- 21 economic benefit and commercial value, present and future traffic
- 22 census and route continuity.
- 23 (3) In acquiring property under this program the Department
- 24 of Transportation shall make every reasonable effort to acquire
- 25 real property under this program expeditiously by negotiation
- 26 before resorting to acquisition by eminent domain proceedings.
- 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 1999.
