1 2 3	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN INSURANCE POLICIES AND PLANS PROVIDE MEDICAL BENEFITS WHEN DENTAL CARE IS PROVIDED UNDER PHYSICIAN-SUPERVISED GENERAL ANESTHESIA; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Every hospital, health or medical expenses
6	insurance policy, hospital or medical service contract, health
7	maintenance organization and preferred provider organization that
8	is delivered or issued for delivery in this state and otherwise
9	provides anesthesia benefits shall provide benefits for anesthesia
10	and for associated facility charges when the mental or physical
11	condition of the insured requires dental treatment to be rendered
12	under physician-supervised general anesthesia in a hospital
13	setting, surgical center or dental office. This required coverage
14	shall include anesthesia services provided by oral and
15	maxillofacial surgeons as permitted by the Mississippi State Board
16	of Dental Examiners.
17	An insurer may require prior authorization for the anesthesia
18	and associated facility charges for dental care procedures in the
19	same manner that prior authorization is required for treatment of
20	other medical conditions under general anesthesia. The benefit
21	provided by this coverage shall be subject to the same annual
22	deductibles or coinsurance established for all other covered
23	benefits within a given policy, plan or contract. Private third
24	party payers may not reduce or eliminate coverage due to these
25	requirements.
26	A dentist shall consider the Indications for General

- 27 Anesthesia as published in the reference manual of the American
- 28 Academy of Pediatric Dentistry as utilization standards for
- 29 determining whether performing dental procedures necessary to
- 30 treat the particular condition or conditions of the patient under
- 31 general anesthesia constitutes appropriate treatment.
- 32 The provisions of this act shall not apply to treatment
- 33 rendered for temporal mandibular joint (TMJ) disorders.
- 34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 1999.
